A Larger Store on the Same Site



Reflecting the steady growth of the bustling north Portland neighborhood, a new 140,000 SF Fred Meyer store—30,000 SF larger than the previous store—opened December 2004. Built on the same site as their previous store, site restrictions required it to be designed to their newer two-story prototype.

Interface contributed mechanical, electrical, plumbing and lighting design specifications, with special effects in the Ladies' Clothing departments, demonstrating the promotional benefits of creating interest with lighting.
